

1 ABOUT NUMIDENT

The **NUMIDENT** (Numerical Identification) files contain Social Security applications, claims, and death records maintained by the Social Security Administration. These records include original SS-5 application data such as name, date and place of birth, parents' names, and other biographical information. The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) provides public access to historical NUMIDENT records, making them a valuable resource for genealogy researchers seeking information about ancestors' Social Security applications, name changes, and death records.
